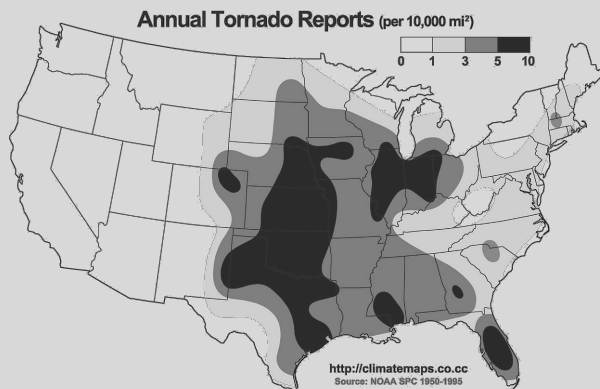
Severe Weather Awareness Week March 2 through 6

What to do before a tornado:

- Check the weather forecast often
- Sign up for emergency notifications
- Create a plan

What to do during a tornado:

- Continue to listen to weather forecasts
- Go to your safe place. Stay away from windows, doors, and outside walls
- Do **NOT** get under an overpass or bridge if outside. You are safer in a low, flat location
- Cover your head and neck
