This Resolution made and entered into this 13th day of July 2021, by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

WHEREAS, the activities of the Hardin County Attorney include the prosecution of cases in Hardin District and Family Court, the provision of legal representation to Hardin County Government; and the establishment and collection of child support under the provisions of title IV-D of the U.S. Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 651, pursuant to contract with the Cabinet for Families and Children, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Attorney desires to operate an effective criminal and civil program utilizing the various funding sources available to the office.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that the Hardin County Attorney is hereby authorized to retain those funds that could be classified as excess fees, if any, and pursuant to KRS 134.545 to expend for any lawful purpose in the operation of the Hardin County Attorney's Office at the discretion of the Hardin County Attorney; and that the Hardin County Attorney may receive directly and expend reimbursements, allocations and/or incentive payments received pursuant to the Title IV-D contract at her discretion, for the purpose of the Hardin County Child Support Program.

Report of Bad Check Fees
Fiscal Year 2021**


This report is submitted for informational purposes in relation to the requirement of KRS 514.040 (5), which requires excess fees received by the county attorney from the prosecution of theft by deception (bad checks) to be turned over to the county treasurer at the end of the Fiscal Year.

For the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, the Hardin County Attorney received **\$18,955.12** in fees for the collection and prosecution of bad check offenses.

For the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, the Hardin County Attorney expended **\$578,867.45** in operating expenses from all other fee sources.

All bad check fees were expended for operating expenses and there is no excess fee money held by the Hardin County Attorney as of June 30, 2021.
