

## Inventory Service Agreement

This inventory service agreement is between Harry L. Berry, Judge Executive 150 North Provident Way, Elizabethtown, KY 42701, representing Hardin County, known as the Land Manager, and Ronald L. Taylor, of 137 Collinbrook Drive, Rineyville, KY, known as Forester.

The Forester agrees to inventory the Pearl Hollow Landfill woodland areas consisting approximately of 1065 acres for timber harvest as directed by the Land Manager:

- Inventory the forestland available for harvest.
- Determine the volume and value of harvestable timber.
- Provide a summary report showing volume and value by species and location.

As compensation for the above work, the land manager agrees to pay to Forester \$1,200 for the above mentioned information.

Land manager further agrees that Hardin County is the sole owner of the property. The landowner also assumes responsibility for correctly identifying the property lines.

The Forester agrees to save harmless and release the land manager and Hardin County from any and all liability for any personal injury sustained on the Hardin County property while providing the services covered by this agreement.

In case of dispute over the terms of this contract we agree to accept the decision of an arbitration board of three selected persons as final. Each of the contracting parties will select one person and the two selected will select a third to form this board.
