

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-153**

BE IT RESOLVED, to levy the following taxes to property owners in Hardin County for the fiscal year 2022-2023:


1. A real estate tax of 11.6 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.2 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund, 0.15 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Soil Conservation District, and 1.80 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service.
2. A personal property, business inventory, documented/non KY registered watercraft and aircraft tax of 11.8 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.2 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund and 2.60 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service.
3. A motor vehicle and watercraft tax of 11.5 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.2 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund, and 1.46 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to levy upon each acre of land within the boundaries of the county, which is subject to the fire protection tax, a tax of 2.0 cents for the Fire Protection Fund.

2022 PROPOSED TAX RATE
PUBLIC HEARING

The Hardin County Fiscal Court will hold a public hearing on 23 August 2022 at 3:30 P.M. in the Hardin County Government Center, 150 N. Provident Way, 3rd Floor, Elizabethtown, Kentucky for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The real property tax rate levied last year was 12.0 cents per \$100 of assessed value to potentially produce real property revenue in the amount of \$8,218,720 and the actual revenue produced was \$7,813,918. This year's proposed tax rate of 11.8 cents per \$100 is projected to produce a total of \$8,418,450 in revenue from real property. Included in this amount would be \$148,838 revenue from "new real property" (net increase in the property added to the tax roll for the current year).

This year's compensating rate is 11.8 cents per \$100 of assessed value (the same rate proposed) and would potentially produce total revenue from real property in the amount of \$8,418,450 if adopted. This year's 4% growth rate would be 12.0 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value and would potentially produce total revenue from real property in the amount of \$8,708,742.

The proposed rate for Personal Property, Business Inventory, Documented/Non KY Registered Watercraft and Aircraft is 11.8 cents per \$100 of assessed value with potential revenue from Personal Property of \$959,129; Motor Vehicle and Watercraft, remains unchanged at the current rate of 11.5 cents per \$100 of assessed value with revenue potential from Motor Vehicle to be \$1,041,709; revenue potential from Watercraft is \$23,255.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for general government expenditures.

Presentation of testimony per KRS 65A100 relating to the following proposed taxes will be provided by the following: Hardin County Extension Service, Real Property is 1.80 cents per \$100 of assessed value; Personal Property, Business Inventory, Documented/Non KY Registered Watercraft is 2.80 cents per \$100 of assessed value and Motor Vehicle and Watercraft is 1.48 cents per \$100 of assessed value; Hardin County Health Department, Real Property is 2.2 cents per \$100 of assessed value; Personal Property, Business Inventory and Documented/Non KY Registered Watercraft is 2.2 cents per \$100 of assessed value and Motor Vehicle and Watercraft is 2.2 cents per \$100 of assessed value; Hardin County Conservation District, Real Property is 0.15 cents per \$100 of assessed value.
