

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-194**

**WHEREAS**, there exists 4.11 acres of land along Highway 1136 in Glendale known locally as Taylor Bend Park and identified by MAP ID# 191-00-00-001;

**WHEREAS**, on May 26, 1970, J.H. and Agnes Taylor conveyed the property to Hardin County, Kentucky to be used as a public park area but did not provide for any costs associated with providing public access, maintenance or improvements;

**WHEREAS**, over the years, the park has become an area for illegal gathering, littering and dumping and for that reason it became necessary to limit public access;

**WHEREAS**, an offer to provide maintenance, programming related to the nearby Camp Nevin and public access for the property has been made by local nonprofit agencies, the General Ben Hardin Helm Camp Sons of the Confederate Veterans and the Ben Hardin Helm United Daughters of the Confederacy Chapter 126 in keeping with the original conveyance.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, and pursuant to KRS 67.0802(4)(e), to transfer the real property known as Taylor Bend Park located at Highway 1136 in Glendale, Kentucky without consideration by Quit Claim Deed to be held in joint tenancy by the General Ben Hardin Helm Camp 1703 Sons of the Confederate Veterans and the Ben Hardin Helm United Daughters of the Confederacy Chapter 126 for the purpose of economic development, more particularly, for the elimination of blight and to carry out the original intended purpose of the transfer to the County;

**ADOPTED**, by Hardin County Fiscal Court in its regular meeting on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2022.




