Job Summary

The purpose of the position is to perform skilled work in the maintenance of gasoline and diesel powered automotive and construction equipment. This position performs mechanical repair and maintenance of automobiles, trucks, tractors, bulldozers, graders and other standard and specialized automobiles and construction equipment

Major Essential Duties

- Perform general overhaul and repair work on light and heavy trucks, gasoline and diesel motors and all county equipment
- Inspect, adjust, repair, recondition and replace necessary units and related parts
- Perform related tasks as required

Minor Essential Duties

- Work overtime when necessary

Qualifications

Education and/or Experience

- Graduate of an accredited high school or equivalent
- Experience in mechanical and road maintenance equipment
- Thorough knowledge of various types of equipment

Language Skills

- Ability to communicate effectively in English both orally and writing
- Ability to read, analyze and interpret policies, procedures, equipment manuals and safety documents
- Ability to write occasional reports

Mathematical Skills

- Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure

Reasoning Ability

- Solves practical problems
- Interprets some technical and instructional material
- Makes decisions which serve the County’s best interest

Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

- Possess a valid Kentucky driver’s license and CDL

Other Knowledge and/or Skills

- Possess general knowledge of standard practices and equipment of the automotive mechanic trade
- Understand the principles of operation of gasoline and diesel engines
- Possess knowledge to perform major repairs on heavy trucks and construction equipment

Physical Demands

While performing job duties, the employee could reasonably be expected to:

Regularly (over 2/3)

- Stand or walk
- Talk or hear
- Lift and/or move up to 25 pounds
- Operate a vehicle

Occasionally (under 1/3)

- Reach with hands and arms
- Use hands to type, handle papers, tools, etc.

Vision requirements include close, distance, color and peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus

Perform heavy manual labor, if necessary, under adverse weather conditions and in difficult working areas

Work Environment
