

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2023-082**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Keith L. Taul, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The resignation of Michael Ray, 56 hour EMT, effective 5 April 2023.
2. The movement of Maisey Cigrand, 56 hour EMT, from Grade 6, Step EOI to Grade 6, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$15.17 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, retroactive 12 March 2023.
3. The movement of Maria Garcia, 56 hour EMT, from Grade 6, Step EOI to Grade 6, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$15.17 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 9 April 2023.
4. The movement of Sebastian Adams, part-time EMT, from Grade 9, Step EOI to Grade 9, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$17.56 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, effective 9 April 2023.
5. The movement of Cassie Mitchell, part-time EMT, from Grade 9, Step EOI to Grade 9, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$17.56 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, effective 9 April 2023.
6. The change of status of Christopher Bombagi from 56 hour Paramedic, Grade 11, Step 2, to part-time Paramedic, Grade 14, Step 2, at \$22.88 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, effective 23 April 2023.
