

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2023-154**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Keith L. Taul, to approve the following retroactive pay rate change within the EMS Department:

1. The change of status of Johnathan Pudinoff from 56 hour EMT- Advanced, Grade 8, Step 2, to part-time EMT-Advanced, Grade 11, Step 2, at \$18.82 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, retroactive 9 October 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Keith L. Taul, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The change of status of Jonathan Pudinoff from part-time EMT- Advanced, Grade 11, Step 3, to 40 hour EMT- Advanced, Grade 12, Step 3, at \$21.80 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 13 August 2023.
2. The change of status of Kieran Miller from 56 hour EMT, Grade 6, Step 2, to part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step 2, at \$18.44 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, effective 30 July 2023.
3. The promotion of Kassandra Mattingly from Paramedic Assistant Shift Supervisor, Grade 12, Step 8, to Paramedic Shift Supervisor, Grade 13, Step 8, at \$24.91 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 16 July 2023.
4. The demotion of Donald Highley, Paramedic Shift Supervisor, Grade 13, Step 7, to 56 hour Paramedic, Grade 11, Step 7, at \$22.25 hourly, effective 30 July 2023.
5. The promotion of Jonathan Martin from Paramedic Assistant Shift Supervisor, Grade 12, Step 8, to Paramedic Shift Supervisor, Grade 13, Step 8, at \$24.91 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 30 July 2023.
