

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2023-094**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Keith L. Taul, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:

1. The change of status of Quentin Pruett from 56 hour EMT, Grade 6, Step 4, to part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step 4, at \$18.64 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$250 per fiscal year, effective 7 May 2023.
2. The movement of Kristen Shartzter, 56 hour Paramedic, from Grade 11, Step EOI to Grade 11, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$19.37 hourly, effective 7 May 2023.
3. The movement of Ryan Strange, part-time EMT –Advanced, from Grade 11, Step EOI to Grade 11, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$19.37 hourly, effective 7 May 2023.
4. The movement of Racheal Goodlett, part-time EMT, from Grade 9, Step EOI to Grade 9, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$17.56 hourly, effective 7 May 2023.
5. The movement of Easter Hiser, 56 hour EMT, from Grade 6, Step EOI to Grade 6, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$15.17 hourly, effective 7 May 2023.
6. The movement of Jonathan Langkabel, part-time Paramedic, from Grade 14, Step EOI to Grade 14, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$22.43 hourly, effective 7 May 2023.
7. The promotion of Olivia Heil from 56 hour EMT, Grade 6, Step 1, to 56 hour EMT-Advanced, Grade 8, Step 1, at \$16.72 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 7 May 2023.
