**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR FELINE TRAP NEUTER RETURN PROGRAM (T.N.R.)**

Friends of the Hardin County Animal Shelter

And

Hardin County Government

This Agreement is entered this 23 day of April, 2024, by and between Hardin County, Kentucky (County) which is charged with providing for animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083 and Friends of the Hardin County Animal Shelter (FOHCAS), a non-profit organization that assists, supports and collaborates with Hardin in carrying out the government purpose of animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083(3)(a) and supports animal health and welfare in Hardin County. The purpose of this agreement is to provide veterinary services at Hardin County Animal Care and Control (HCACC) for those animals served through HCACC and FOHCAS's Community Cat program.

Now, therefore, the County and FOHCAS, in order to achieve the mutual goals stated above, do hereby agree as follows:

1. The County will provide spay/neuter services for unowned cats (a/k/a community cats) in accordance with the goals and guidelines of the Community Cat Program.
2. The County will not provide these services to the general public or for any animals that are not HCACC and FOHCAS served animals.
3. The County will provide spay and neuter services, rabies injections and ear tip services for \$35.00 per cat. HCACC will invoice FOHCAS

monthly for services provided, not to exceed an average of 65 cats per month or 780 cats per year

5. FOHCAS will submit payment to Hardin County Government within thirty (30 days) of receipt of each invoice.
6. This agreement is for an initial term of 1 year and will renew for successive 1 year terms thereafter unless either party provides 90-day written notice to the other party of its desire to terminate this agreement.
