


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT

## **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

**Nolin River Wildlife**

**And**

**Hardin County Government**

This Agreement is entered this 23 day of April, 2024, by and between Hardin County, Kentucky (County) which is charged with providing for animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083 and Nolin River Wildlife (NRW), a non-profit organization that assists, supports and collaborates with County in carrying out the government purpose of animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083(3)(a) and supports animal health and welfare in Hardin County. The purpose of this agreement is to provide veterinary services at Hardin County Animal Care and Control (HCACC) for those animals served through HCACC, including those animals for which HCACC and NRW collaborate for shelter, placement and the well-being of animals in Hardin County.

Now, therefore, the County and NRW, in order to achieve the mutual goals stated above, do hereby agree as follows:

1. The County will provide fee-based veterinarian services to animals served through NRW. All service requests will flow from NRW's director to the HCACC director.
2. Services will be provided at 220 Peterson Drive, Elizabethtown, Kentucky. Services rendered to NRW are secondary to HCACC's normal operations unless an animal is considered in imminent danger by NRW's director and HCACC's director.

3. Fees for services will be determined on a case-by-case basis and are subject to a final determination by the HCACC Director.
4. Services to NRW requiring the veterinarian to leave 220 Peterson Drive will be subject to a trip fee of \$150.00 plus \$75.00 per hour.
5. All surgical and emergency services will only be provided at 220 Peterson Drive. Only wellness exams will be done off premises.
6. Hardin County Director reserves the right to refuse service to anyone who may willingly damage the reputation of Hardin County Animal Care and Control or who may cause a toxic or hostile work environment.
7. This agreement is for a term of two (2) years. Either party must provide a 30-day written notice to the other party of its desire to terminate this agreement.
8. All subsequent renewals shall increase or decrease in cost in accordance with changes in the Consumer Price Index, all urban consumers, all items, unadjusted as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor statistics, hereinafter referred to as "CPI."
