IN SUPPORT OF RENAMING A SECTION OF THE BYPASS FROM
HIGHWAY 62 TO NEW GLENDALE ROAD
IN HONOR OF DEPUTY SHERIFF BILLY EDWARDS AND KATHY EDWARDS**

- Whereas,** the people of Hardin County have great admiration and the utmost gratitude for all the men and women who have selflessly served their country and this community in the armed forces and in public safety and public health, especially Deputy Sheriff Billy Edwards and Kathy Edwards; and
- Whereas,** Deputy Sheriff Edwards and his wife Kathy have paid the high price by placing themselves in harm's way for the good of all, either by serving in law enforcement and in the healthcare field; and
- Whereas,** Deputy Sheriff Edwards served in the armed forces and as a public servant in the Elizabethtown Police Department with the rank of Sergeant before retiring in 2013 and then serving with the Hardin County Sheriff's Office and Kathy served in the healthcare field for over 20 plus years, always caring for others even through the pandemic; and
- Whereas,** they selflessly cared for all that they knew, worked with, treated, and cared for in more ways than can be expressed in words; and
- Whereas,** tragically their lives ended together in a terrible motorcycle accident on July 14, 2024 with their families lives, coworkers lives and friends lives forever changed on this day; and
- Whereas,** Hardin County would like to officially designate a section of highway to Deputy Sheriff Billy Edwards and his wife Kathy for them to be forever remembered and honored in this community; and


