RESOLUTION NO. 2024-167**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Keith L. Taul, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:

1. The resignation of Brionna Taylor, part-time EMT, effective 7 August 2024.
2. The resignation of Dominic Vigil, part-time EMT, effective 1 August 2024.
3. The change of status of Zachary Perry from part-time EMT-Advanced, Grade 11, Step EOI, to 56 hour EMT- Advanced, Grade 8, Step EOI, at \$17.22 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 25 August 2024.
4. The change of status of William Sawyer from part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step 2, to 56 hour EMT, Grade 6, Step 2, at \$16.24 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$500 per fiscal year, effective 8 September 2024.
