

**COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT**

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-199

WHEREAS, KRS 381.755 permits a property owner upon which a grave or cemetery is located to petition the Fiscal Court for an Order allowing remains to be moved;

WHEREAS, Nelle Niceley Johnson, the owner of property located at 1750 Gaither Station Road, Elizabethtown KY (PVA# 187-00-00-028), identified as Parcel 1 in Deed Book 1573, Page 354 in the office of the Hardin County Court Clerk, petitioned the Hardin Fiscal Court by letter dated July 17, 2024 to allow the remains of certain of her family members located there to be removed and relocated to the Elizabethtown City Cemetery;

WHEREAS, the property owner advertised a Public Notice published in the News Enterprise on July 24, 2024, notifying the public of her desire, intent and request for an Order to remove and relocate the graves and of the date and time of this matter being heard by Fiscal Court;

WHEREAS, 60 days having passed since publication of notice of the intended action;

WHEREAS, the property owner and descendent of those buried on the property has assured Hardin Fiscal Court that third parties with which she has contracted will pay all expenses associated with the removal and relocation of the remains;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. That it is in the best interests of the property owner who is the descendant of those buried upon the property, to remove and relocate the remains located upon 1750 Gaither Station Road, Elizabethtown, KY to a more suitable location at the Elizabethtown City Cemetery;

2. That the property owner, Nelle Niceley Johnson, is hereby authorized to have removed and relocated the remains and shall pay all expenses associated with such.
